Key topics:

- Principles and practices of character development education
- Creating classrooms, schools, and learning communities based on a youth-centered approach

Teambuilding & Communication Workshop *Serves up to 100 educators. 6 hours of training.*

EduCare's Teambuilding Workshop involves participants in developing tools and techniques for more effectively managing on-the-job relationships, communication, and problem-solving skills.

Key topics:

- Improving communication and listening skills
- Building trust and respect
- Developing flexibility as a key for creative decision-making

Higher Ground: Teaching Conflict Management Workshop *Serves up to 100 educators. 6 hours of training.*

A workshop available to schools, colleges, churches/synagogues, youth organizations, educators, and community leaders in win-win approaches to violence prevention, tolerance-building, conflict resolution, and peer mediation.

Key topics:

- Approaches for teaching students the skills of tolerance-building and conflict resolution
- Methods for assisting youth in expressing their feelings appropriately and managing anger
- Activities for increasing understanding and acceptance of differences
- Techniques for integrating conflict resolution into classroom management and disciplinary strategies
- Curriculum materials for teaching global ethics, moral courage and wise decision-making skills

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Educator Institute for Teaching and Learning

Serves up to 100 educators. 30 hours of training (4 class sessions plus homework).

Educators acquire the tools, techniques, and resources to teach an additional 3 Rs — Respect, Resiliency, and Responsibility — and build “safe” and caring learning environments that foster tolerance, creativity, and an increase in student learning and achievement.

Key topics:

- Personal and professional development for the educator: *“We teach who we are...”*
- Honoring and teaching the whole child — integrating cognitive, emotional, social, and real world / achievement skills
- Tolerance and resiliency skill-building — how to create “safe” schools from the inside out
- Character development, emotional literacy, and asset-building
- Curriculum and concrete strategies to implement in your school or organization
